1. The present Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus, directing the respondent to produce the daughter of the petitioner, namely, Ms. Anisha.

4. In view of the fact that Ms. Anisha, who is a major, is staying with Mr. Vinit Kumar out of her own freewill and volition, no further orders are required to be passed in this present petition. The same is, accordingly, disposed of.
