1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.
2. The present petition under Section 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 seeks the following prayers: -

“a) initiate contempt proceedings against the respondent/contemnor for not complying with the order dated 18.07.2017 passed in L.P.A. No.447 of 2013, titled as *"Naresh Kumar Gupta Vs. Canara Bank"* by the Hon'ble Division Bench of the Hon'ble High Court, at New Delhi;
