1. The petitioner has not taken recourse to the alternative remedy under Section 5(5) of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act, 2002 ['PMLA']. The decision, therefore, in the case of *M/s Revati Cements Pvt. Ltd. vs. Union of India*,¹ would have no application.
