ORDER

1. This petition raises grievances of injustice concerning the abrupt displacement of long-serving conductors who have been operating Delhi's public transport system under the Cluster Bus Scheme for over 10-15 years.
2. Counsel for the Petitioner, after making some submissions, seeks leave to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach the Labour Court/Conciliation Officer. She further requests that, in view of the facts of the case, the Labour Court/Conciliation Officer be requested to expedite the Petitioner's case.
3. Considering the above, leave and liberty, as prayed for, are granted.



Having regard to the peculiar facts of the case, it is directed that, as and when the Petitioner invokes the jurisdiction of the Labour Court/Conciliation Officer, the proceedings be taken up and decided expeditiously.

4. With the aforesaid directions, the petition is disposed of, along with all pending applications.
