1. The present petition is directed against the order dated 10.09.2025 passed by the learned Family Court, whereby *ad interim* maintenance of Rs. 40,000/- has been granted in favour of the respondent. I am, however, informed that the application under Section 125 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, is still pending consideration before the learned Family Court.
2. Mr. Abhinav Sharma, learned counsel for the petitioner, submits that the petitioner shall approach the learned Family Court for an expeditious decision on the application for interim maintenance.
3. In view of the above submission, the present petition, alongwith pending applications, is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the learned Family Court in this regard.
4. The learned Family Court may consider the application in accordance with its own roster and the age of the matters pending before



it.

5. It is clarified that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case, and all rights and contentions of the parties are left open to be considered by the learned Family Court.
