W.P.(C) 3948/2026

1. The instant petition seeks a direction for the repair/maintenance of a drain/*nala* in Manglapuri, Ward No. 119, Palam Dabri Road and to ensure that no water percolates into the adjoining building at any time. A further prayer for directions to the respondents to periodically repair and clean the drain/*nala*.
2. The provisions under Section 152 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 ['BNSS'] would clearly indicate that the concerned District Magistrate or the Sub-Divisional Magistrate is fully empowered to look into



all those aspects and to issue a conditional order. It appears that the petitioner has not made a comprehensive representation in terms of Section 152 of the BNSS.

3. Let the petitioner to file a comprehensive representation before the concerned District Magistrate who, in turn, is directed to look into the petitioner's grievance with due expedition and to pass an appropriate order in accordance with law.

4. With these observations, the petition stands disposed of.

5. All rights and contentions are left open.

6. If the petitioner's grievance is not fully mitigated, he shall be at liberty to take appropriate recourse in accordance with law.
