ORDER

01.04.2026

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1. Applicant seeks regular bail in case FIR No.523/2024 dated 28.12.2024, registered at Police Station Shakarpur, for commission of offences under Section 420 IPC.
2. The charges have already been ascertained. However, complainant is yet to enter into witness box.
3. After hearing arguments for some time, learned counsel for the applicant, without prejudice to his rights and contentions, does not press the present application, at this juncture. He, however, seeks permission to file application afresh once the complainant is examined. He also submits that prosecution may be directed to ensure his presence before the learned Trial Court without any delay. He contends that since the applicant is around 70 years of age and is not keeping well, the applicant may also be permitted to file application seeking interim bail on health grounds, before the learned

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Trial Court.

4. Learned Addl. P.P. for the State assures that there would not be any delay or inaction on their part and every effort would be made to ensure the presence of the complainant before the learned Trial Court on the next date of hearing which is 24.04.2026.
5. In view of the above, the present application is disposed of as not pressed.
6. Liberty, as prayed, is granted.
7. Pending applications also stand disposed of.
8. All rights and contentions of parties are reserved.
