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1. Learned counsel for the appellant, on instructions, states that without prejudice to the rights and contentions raised in the civil suit pending before the Trial Court, he confines his relief to the submission that the respondents be directed to maintain and file a statement of account, seeking restrain on the respondents from using the sum. of Rs.10,00,00,000/-, lying in the form of FDR.

2. Learned counsel for respondents, on instructions, states that the respondent undertakes that, in case, any amount is withdrawn from the said



FDR, a detailed statement of account will be maintained and filed before the Trial Court periodically.

3. Needless to state, that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case, and the present appeal is disposed of, in view of the statements made today.

4. It is further clarified that, in case, the appellant is aggrieved by any further action, it shall be open for him to approach the Trial Court by way of an appropriate application.
