3. In substance, the Petitioner prays for implementation of order passed by the learned Central Administrative Tribunal on 11.07.2016 in O.A. No. 3306/2013.
4. Pertinently, the Petitioner had also filed a contempt petition in this regard, which was disposed of by the learned Tribunal on 26.09.2025 with liberty to file a fresh petition.
5. Instead of filing a fresh petition, the Petitioner has invoked the



extraordinary jurisdiction of this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

6. Undisputedly, for implementation of an order passed by the learned Tribunal, the remedy is to file execution / contempt.

7. In view of the same, the present writ petition along with the pending application is disposed of with the aforesaid observations.
