ORDER

1. By way of the present petition under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 ["BNSS"], the petitioner assails the order dated 13.02.2026, by which the learned Magistrate's Court has directed that process be issued against him under Section 84 of the BNSS, returnable on 16.04.2026.
2. It is evident from the contents of the petition that the petitioner had earlier sought anticipatory bail before this Court [BAIL. APPLN. 4809/2025: *Pranshu Agarwal v. State of NCT of Delhi and Anr.*], but withdrew the same on 12.02.2026.
3. After some arguments, Mr. Barun Kumar Sinha, learned counsel



for the petitioner, submits that the petitioner is willing to appear before the learned Trial Court on 16.04.2026, and seeks to reserve the rights and contentions of the petitioner before the learned Magistrate's Court.

4. In view of the above submission, no further orders are required in this petition.

5. Accordingly, the petition, alongwith pending applications, is disposed of.

6. It is made clear that this Court has not made any comment on the merits of the case, which shall be considered by the learned Magistrate's Court in accordance with law.
