1. This is an application filed under Section 151 of CPC, 1908 seeking clarification of the order dated 10.02.2026 passed in the main petition and more particularly paragraph Nos. 6 and 7.
2. Ms. Singh, learned counsel for the applicant/ petitioner, states that the paragraph Nos. 6 and 7 of the order dated 10.02.2026 show that the Court has granted legitimacy to the Ad-hoc Committee appointed on 13.10.2023, which was the ground of challenge in the petition. Additionally, she states in paragraph No. 7 of the said order the averments of Ms. Khanna, learned counsel for the respondent Nos. 1



and 2, are incorrect.

3. Since the order has been passed and a Returning Officer has been appointed for conducting fresh elections, the Court has not commented on the validity of the Ad-hoc Committee or the suspension of the petitioner, and has only recorded the statements of the counsels of the respective parties.
4. With these observations, the present application is disposed of.
