1. The Petitioner's limited grievance in the present petition pertains to the inaction on the part of the Statutory Appellate Authority (Respondent No. 1) in deciding his statutory appeal dated 25th September, 2025. In this regard, upon a pointed query by the Court, Mr. Tushar Ranjan Mohanty, counsel for the Petitioner, submits that while the rules do not prescribe any specific timeline, there are administrative instructions envisaging that action ought to be taken within a period of one month.
