1. Present petition seeks cancellation of anticipatory bail and also expunging/deleting certain observations made by the learned Trial Court *vide* order dated 16.02.2026, whereby it has observed that matter appears to be civil in nature.
2. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that when revision petition was filed by the petitioner, learned Revisional Court had, categorically, observed that there was *prima facie* commission of offences punishable under Sections 447/448/453/506 IPC read with Section 120-B IPC.
3. Learned Addl. P.P. for State/R-1 and learned counsel for respondent No. 2 appear on advance notice.
4. Fact, however, remains that any observation made by any such Court, while dealing with regular bail application or anticipatory bail application, are

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only *prima facie* and tentative in nature and these cannot be taken as final expression on the merits of the case.

5. In view of the aforesaid clarification, learned counsel for petitioner does not press for any further relief at the moment.

6. Petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
