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1. Petitioners seek quashing of case FIR No. 579/2023 of PS Nangloi for offence under Section 279/304A IPC and Section 3/181/5/180 Motor Vehicles Act on the ground that complainant *de facto* (respondent no.2) has compromised the disputes with the petitioners.
