By virtue of the present petition under *Article 226* of the Constitution of India read with *Section 528* of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, the petitioner seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of *Mandamus*, directing the respondent to release the petitioner on parole for a period of *eight weeks*.
