1. By virtue of the bail application under *Section 482* of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, the applicant seeks grant of anticipatory bail in E-FIR No.08/2026 dated 07.01.2026 registered under Sections 318(4)/340 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 at PS: Cyber Crime, Rohini, Sector-17, New Delhi.
