ORDER

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1. The present petition has been filed seeking the following reliefs:-

i. Issue an appropriate writ, order or direction directing
the Respondents to strictly enforce the provisions of
the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 and the Delhi Motor
Vehicles Rules, 1993, particularly Rules 7B and 95A,



- with respect to vehicles transporting school children in the vicinity of the Petitioner school;
- ii. Issue directions to the Respondents to prohibit and take strict action against private LMV (Non-Transport) vehicles and unauthorized cab operators illegally ferrying school children without valid commercial permits and compliance with statutory safety norms;
 - iii. Direct the respondent no. 2 and 3 that only duly authorized and registered school transport vehicles with valid commercial permits be allowed to operate for the purpose of transporting students;
 - iv. Direct strict compliance with safety norms including capacity limits, verified drivers, female attendants, and other safety requirements prescribed under the Delhi Motor Vehicles Rules;
 - v. Direct the Respondents to frame and implement a proper regulatory mechanism or standard operating procedure (SOP) for monitoring and regulating vehicles engaged in transportation of school children in the National Capital Territory of Delhi;
 - vi. Direct the Respondents to conduct regular inspections and enforcement drives against unauthorized school transport vehicles;

2. Having heard the counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of while directing the petitioner School to make an appropriate representation to the Deputy Commission of Police (Traffic) and to the Transport Department, Government of NCT of Delhi giving complete particulars of the cabs/taxis which are operating in the vicinity of the School in violation of the relevant government rules and regulations including the School Cab Policy.

3. Upon the representation being made, the Deputy Commission of Police (Traffic), as well as the Transport Department, GNCTD, shall consider the



same and proceed to take appropriate action in accordance with law.
