1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for violation of the order dated 08.10.2024 and 11.02.2025 passed in W.P.(C) 11984/2024.

6. Needless to add that any party aggrieved will be at liberty to take appropriate action in accordance with law.
7. The petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
