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1. The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following reliefs:-

- a. Issue a Writ in the nature of Mandamus or any other appropriate Writ, Order, or Direction, directing Respondent No. 1 (BSES) to take necessary action regarding the illegally installed electricity meter at the suit property, comprising Mustatil No. 116, Killa No. 19, situated at Village Dichaun Kalan, Delhi bearing CA No. 153497278 & CA No. 153646639; and
- b. Issue a Writ in the nature of Mandamus or any other appropriate Writ, Order, or Direction, directing Respondent No. 1 (BSES) to immediately disconnect the electricity connection installed in the name of Respondent No. 2 and 3 bearing No. CA No. 153497278 & CA No. 153646639 at the subject property; and



c. Issue a Writ in the nature of Mandamus or any other appropriate Writ, Order, or Direction, directing Respondent No. 1 (BSES) to conduct a thorough inquiry into the fraudulent installation of the electricity meter and take appropriate action against the officials found to be in collusion with Respondent No. 2 and Respondent No. 3; and

2. It is contended on behalf of the petitioners that electricity connection has been granted in favour of respondents no.2 and 3 on the basis of forged documents.
3. To be noted, petitioners are related to respondents no.2 and 3 and there is a civil suit, which is ongoing in respect of the subject property.
4. On 20th August, 2025, a complaint was filed by the petitioners with the respondent no.1/ BSES Rajdhani Power Limited (BRPL).
5. Having heard the counsel for the parties, the present writ petition is disposed of while directing the respondent no.1/ BRPL to consider the complaint filed by the petitioner and pass a speaking order within eight (8) weeks from today.
6. Pending application also stands disposed of.
