1. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. Application stands disposed of.

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3. The present writ petition has been filed on behalf of petitioner seeking issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondent to release the petitioner on parole for a period of four weeks to carry out necessary repairs in his house which is in a dilapidated condition, and to attend marriage of his brother-in-law which is scheduled for 07.05.2026.
4. The learned ASC for the State submits that the petitioner had applied for grant of parole before the Jail Authorities on 09.02.2026 which has yet



not been decided by the competent authorities.

5. In view thereof, the concerned authority is directed to decide the application of the petitioner, pending before it regarding grant of parole, within a period of two weeks, while also considering the present petition as a representation, under intimation to the petitioner.

6. In view of the above terms, the present petition stands disposed of.
