1. Learned counsel for the respondent nos.2 and 3, as per instructions, oppose the present petition for quashing of the FIR No.74/2012 dated 02.07.2012 under *Sections 406/420/467/468/471/120B* of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at PS.: Economic Offence Wing, Delhi sought on the basis of the settlement *inter se* the parties.
