2. In the event of any officer, who is being promoted to the said post is on leave of any kind, except Study leave/foreign assignment/deputation, etc. on the date of promotion, this order will take actual effect from the date he/she returns from such leave and assumes charge of the post.

3. On promotion to the post of Senior Administrative Grade, the pay of the officers shall be fixed in Level-14 (Rs.1,44,200 - Rs. 2,18,200) [pre-revised pay scale of Rs. 37,400-67,000/- in the PB-4 with Grade Pay of Rs. 10,000/-] plus NPA at the prescribed rates under of CCS (RP) Rules, 2008 and CCS(RP) Rules, 2016 as amended from time to time.

4. The seniority of the officers will be regulated on the basis of the inter-se seniority in the grade of Medical Officer of the Central Health Service or as may be determined by the Government in accordance with the relevant rules.

5. The promotion to the grade of Senior Administrative Grade (SAG) does not involve change in the present place of posting.

6. The charge relinquishment report as Chief Medical Officer and charge assumption report as Chief Medical Officer (NFSG) (in duplicate) in respect of the officers may be obtained and forwarded to this Ministry.
