1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India seeking contempt proceedings against the respondent bank for wilful disobedience of the directions passed in the Order dated 25.03.2026 in W.P. (C) 3887/2026.
