1. The petitioner (sister of the deceased) and her father are present in Court.
2. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that, without prejudice to his



rights and contentions, he would not press the present petitions whereby they seek cancellation of bail granted to Kalesh and Bharat Ahuja. He, however, submits that since the material public witnesses have already been examined, therefore, the learned Trial Court may be requested to expedite the disposal.
