ORDER

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05.05.2026

1. The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following reliefs:-

- a. Issue a writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order or direction directing the Respondents No. 1 & 2 to forthwith provide the Assessment List for the year 2026-2027 and the extracts thereof, as sought by the Petitioners, in digital form via email, in terms of Section 70 of the NDMC Act, 1994, and in line with the directions issued by this Hon'ble Court in W.P.(C) 6016/2025, wherein the Respondents were permitted to furnish such information in digital form;
- b. Direct the Respondents to extend the time for filing objections for a reasonable period after providing access to the Assessment List and prescribed form, so as to enable the Petitioner to exercise his statutory rights effectively;



2. Counsel for the petitioner has drawn attention of the Court to the order passed by this Court on 7th May, 2025, in W.P. (C) 6016/2025 filed by the same petitioner against the NDMC. The operative directions passed in the said writ petition are set out below:-

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15. Considering the aforesaid, the respondent-NDMC is directed to provide the extracts of the PID numbers, as mentioned aforesaid, to the petitioners through the e-mails, as noted, hereinabove.

16. Let the needful be done by the NDMC within a period of two days, from today.

17. It is further directed that as an when the Assessment List is finalised,



the same shall also be provided to the petitioner on the Emails, as noted hereinabove.”

3. Accordingly, following the directions passed in the said order, the respondent-NMDC is directed to offer inspection to the petitioner of the assessment list in respect of the aforesaid properties within one (1) week from today.
4. In the event the petitioner requests for extracts from the assessment list for the aforesaid properties, the same shall also be provided through email. The petitioner shall have right to file objections to extracts from the assessment list within one (1) week from the date on which extracts are provided.
5. The petition is disposed of with the aforesaid directions.
