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1. The present Appeal, filed under Section 37(2)(b) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 read with Section 13 of the Commercial Courts Act, 2015, seeks to challenge the Order dated



06.03.2026 passed by the learned Arbitral Tribunal.

2. At the outset, Mr. Chinmoy Pradip Sharma and Mr. Viraj Datar, learned Senior Counsel appearing on behalf of the Appellants, submit that in the event they are permitted to raise all contentions, as sought to be urged in the present Appeal, before the learned Arbitral Tribunal, they would seek to withdraw the present Appeal.
