1. The accused/applicant seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 61/2026 of Police Station Mansarovar Park for offence under Section 318(4)/329(3)/336(3)/3(5) BNS.
2. The significant aspects are that the original documents, which are alleged to be forged by the accused/applicant, are not being produced before the IO because according to the accused/applicant, he had handed over the same to his erstwhile counsel for filing the civil suit but that counsel has not returned those documents. Admittedly, no exemption from original documents was filed in the suit. Further, it appears that on 03.12.2025, a complaint of the present accused/applicant was received at PS Mansarovar



Park and was assigned DD No. 72A, which would show that the accused/applicant anticipated a dispute, but would still hand over the original documents to the counsel.

3. After addressing at length, learned counsel for accused/applicant, on instructions, seeks permission to withdraw this anticipatory bail application so that he may surrender and apply for regular bail.

4. As requested, the anticipatory bail application and the accompanying application are dismissed as withdrawn.
