1. Exemptions allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The application stands disposed of.

W.P.(C) 6339/2026 & CM APPL. 31205/2026

3. The Petitioner is a parking contractor, who participated in a notice inviting tender for allotment of various parking sites, including parking site at 'Sukha Ped', on monthly license fee basis.
4. The parking site at 'Sukha Ped' has been allotted to Respondent No. 2.
5. Now, the Petitioner claims that Respondent No. 2 has obtained



the allotment while relying upon fabricated affidavit, declaration and certificate. It is claimed that an amount of ₹4,31,41,984/- is due and recoverable from Respondent No. 2.

6. The Petitioner has also submitted a representation on 28.04.2026 to the authorities detailing his grievance.

7. Keeping in view the aforesaid position, the writ petition is disposed of while directing the Municipal Corporation of Delhi to consider the Petitioner's representation and dispose of the same by passing a speaking order within next two weeks.
