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3. The petitioner is for the following reliefs:



“A. Issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate Writ, Order or Direction directing the Respondent Nos. 1 to 4 to defreeze and restore full operational access to the Petitioner's SBI Bank Account bearing No. 53034801918 & IFSC Code: SBIN0001407, Salabatpura Branch (01407), Surat, Gujarat.

B. To direct the Respondents No. 1 to 4 to strictly comply with the judicial order dated 08.10.2025 passed by the Ld. ACJM, South-East District, Saket Courts, Delhi, within a time-bound period as may be fixed by this Hon'ble Court.

C. Award appropriate. compensation and/or exemplary damages to the Petitioner for the illegal, arbitrary and disproportionate freezing of his bank account, for the consequent financial hardship, mental agony and harassment suffered by him, for the costs of litigation incurred, and for the wilful non-compliance of the judicial order dated 08.10.2025 passed by the Learned ACJM, South-East District, Saket Courts, Delhi, as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the present Case.”

4. However, at this stage, it is submitted that the Bank Account of the petitioner has been defreezed.

5. In view thereof, the petition has been rendered infructuous, and, accordingly, the same stands dismissed.
