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1. By virtue of the present petition under *Article 226* of the Constitution of India read with *Section 528* of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, the petitioner *inter alia* seeks the following reliefs:

“b) Directing the SHO concerned of P.S. Burari to register an FIR on the complaint of the petitioner regarding the illegal dispossession of the petitioner from the property on 17.04.2026 and the removal of her belongings by Respondent Nos. 1 to 4 and other police officials involved therein, and to conduct a fair and impartial investigation in accordance with law;”

2. After some arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file afresh with better



particulars.

3. Accordingly, the present petition, alongwith pending applications, is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
