1. Heard the Appellant appearing in person as well as Mr. Dhananjaya Mishra, learned Counsel for Respondent No.1 and Mr. Amritesh Mohanty, learned Counsel for Respondent No.2.
2. The present Appeal seeks to challenge the order dated 28.04.2026 ("**Impugned Order**") passed by the learned Single Judge whereby W.P.(C) No.60/2026 ("**Writ Petition**") instituted by the Appellant has been dismissed.
3. The learned Single Judge refused to entertain the Writ Petition on the ground that the Appellant in the Writ Petition had not disclosed the filing of writ petitions and the Letters Patent Appeal, earlier preferred by the Appellant, for overlapping prayers. There is nothing on record which can establish that the prayers made in the Writ Petition were not overlapping and stood concluded by earlier proceedings.



4. Accordingly, we do not see any reason to interfere with the Impugned Order passed by the learned Single Judge.
5. The Appeal as well as the pending Application stands dismissed.
