**ORDER**

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**14.05.2026**

1. The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following reliefs:-
  - a. Issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of Certiorary thereby Quashing the Letter Bearing No AC/RPC/MCD/2026/D-251 Dated 23.04.2026 issued by the Respondent for Discontinuation of Temporary Parking Site at K-Block, Kalkaji Park w.e.f 24.05.2026 as null and void;
  - b. Issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus or any other writ thereby restraining the Respondent to take over the possession and discontinue the operation of Parking Site "MCD Park Opposite Govind Puri K Block, Gali no. 1, Kalkaji namely "Govind Puri, K-Block, Kalkaji" and/or handover the same to Horticulture Department, Central Zone, MCD;



- c. Issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus or any other writ directing the Respondent to strictly adhere to the framework as prescribed under the Master Plan Delhi-2021 in respect of Parking in respect of notified Commercial Area/Stretch approved under the Master Plan Delhi, 2021;
  - d. Alternatively, Issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus or any other writ directing the Respondent to handover the running and operation of the Parking Site "MCD Park Opposite Govind Puri K Block, Gali no. 1, Kalkaji namely "Govind Puri, K-Block, Kalkaji" to the Petitioner No. 3, upon conclusion of the tender awarded in favour of the present contractor;
2. The petitioners no.1 and 2 are the Residents Welfare Associations (RWAs) and the petitioner no.3 is a Market Association in the locality of *Govindpuri, Kalkaji, New Delhi-110019*. The petitioners are aggrieved by the letter dated 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2026 issued by the respondent/MCD for discontinuation of the subject parking site. Multiple representations have been made by the petitioners to MCD (Annexure P-8 to P-14 of the writ petition), which are not being considered.
3. Mr. Rajiv Saxena, senior counsel appearing for the petitioners, submits that the subject parking, which is being used by the residents as well as shopkeepers, is being discontinued in order to hold religious/social functions such as *Ramleela* and *Dussehra* at the parking site. He has drawn the attention of the Court to the order passed by this Court on 22<sup>nd</sup> September, 2023, in W.P.(C) 12568/2023, wherein a specific statement had been made on behalf of MCD that the subject site will not be used for social/religious functions.
4. Having heard the counsel for the parties, the writ present petition is disposed of while directing the respondent/MCD to decide the



representations of the petitioners within ten (10) days from today by passing a speaking order.

5. Liberty is given to the petitioner to approach the Court in the event the representations of the petitioner are decided against them.
