1. By way of the present petition under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, the petitioners assail the summoning order dated 17.01.2026, passed by the Magistrate's Court in Complaint Case No. 650/2025 under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 ["the DV Act"].
