ORDER

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1. Applicant seeks regular bail in case arising out of FIR No.67/2018 dated 20.02.2018, registered at P.S. Jyoti Nagar, Delhi, for commission of offence under Section 363 IPC. Subsequently, in the charge-sheet, offences under Sections 376D/377/328/506/34 IPC were added.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant, in all fairness, admits that all the material witnesses have already been examined and the next date of hearing before the learned Trial Court is 25.05.2026, for examination of the sole remaining witness i.e. Investigating Officer of the case.
3. After hearing arguments for some time, learned counsel for the applicant, without prejudice to his rights and contentions, does not press the present application. He, however, submits that in view of long incarceration

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period of the applicant, learned Trial Court be requested to expedite the disposal of the case.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as not pressed.
5. All rights and contentions of the parties are reserved.
6. Learned Trial Court is requested to expedite the disposal of the abovesaid case, particularly, keeping in mind the long incarceration period of applicant.
7. Pending applications also stand disposed of.
8. A copy of this order be also sent to learned Trial Court for information.
