1. The applicants, who are father and son, have approached this Court seeking anticipatory bail in connection with FIR No. 165/2026 dated 07.05.2026, registered at Police Station Baba Haridas Nagar, District Dwarka, Delhi, under Sections 110/115(2)/126(2)/3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

2. After some hearing, Mr. Lal Singh Thakur, learned counsel for the



applicants, seeks permission to withdraw the present applications, while seeking the following clarifications:

- A. That any coercive action against the applicants shall be taken only strictly in accordance with law and after completion of all legal formalities; and
- B. That the police shall also proceed in accordance with law in respect of the complaint dated 16.05.2026 submitted by Sanjeev Kumar Sharma (applicant in BAIL APPLN. 2005/2026) against the complainant and his family members.

4. The bail applications, alongwith the pending applications, are disposed of in terms of the aforesaid submissions.
5. It is clarified that this Court has not made any observation on the merits of the case, and all rights and contentions of the parties in any future application(s) are left open.
