1. By way of the present petition under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, the petitioner assails the chargesheet filed in connection with FIR No. 29/2025 dated 29.01.2025, registered at Crime Branch Police Station under Sections 318(4)/316(2)/61(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, as well as the order dated 13.08.2025 passed by the learned Magistrate taking cognisance thereof.
2. As the order dated 13.08.2025 is amenable to revision before the Sessions Court, Mr. Chirag Madan, learned counsel for the petitioner, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition without prejudice to the petitioner's remedies before the Sessions Court. He further submits that the petitioner be permitted to seek condonation of delay in filing the



revision petition before the Sessions Court.

3. The petition, alongwith the pending applications, is dismissed as withdrawn, without prejudice to the rights and contentions of the petitioner before the Revisional Court. In the event an application for condonation of delay is filed, the same may also be considered by the Revisional Court in accordance with law.

4. The rights and contentions of the petitioner before the Trial Court as well as the Revisional Court are kept open. This Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the matter.
