1. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.

2. The present writ petition has been filed impugning the Notifications/ Circulars dated 3rd February, 2015, 30th April, 2015, 29th March, 2022 and 7th May, 2026 passed by the respondent-GNCTD.

3. The grievance of the petitioner is that the respondent-GNCTD has arbitrarily imposed the requirement that sale of an E-Rickshaw can only be made in favour of a person holding a valid Driving License issued by the respondent-GNCTD. It is submitted that the aforesaid requirement is *de hors* the provisions of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 and the Central Motor Vehicle Rules, 1989.



4. Issue notice.
5. Notice is accepted by counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-GNCTD.
6. Having heard the counsel for the parties, it is deemed appropriate that the present writ petition be treated as a representation to the respondent-GNCTD. The same shall be decided by respondent-GNCTD within six (6) weeks from today, after giving a hearing to the representative of the petitioner.
7. The writ petition, along with pending applications, stands disposed of.
8. Liberty is given to the petitioner to approach this Court in the event, the petitioner has any grievance with the order passed by the respondent-GNCTD on the aforesaid representation of the petitioner.
