1. It is informed by counsel for respondents that *vide* order dated 4th September 2025, suit filed by petitioner/plaintiff being CS No.1037/2017, has since been dismissed in view of provisions of Section 8 of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, as there was an arbitration clause in question.
2.
