1. By virtue of the present petition under *Articles 226/227* of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks direction to the learned Family Court-01, Shahdara, Karkardooma Courts, Delhi (*learned Family Court*) to dispose of MT Case No.444/2019 within a period of six months.

2. Considering the factual matrix involved, the legal position as also since the present proceedings are arising out of a matrimonial discord *inter se* the parties, which also involves a child, the learned Family Court, is requested to adjudicate upon the proceedings by making an endeavour to bring a closure to the same by passing the final judgment therein at the earliest in accordance with law, preferably on or before 31.12.2026, *albeit*, keeping the board position and pendency before it in mind.
