1. The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following reliefs:-

- (a) Direct the respondent to ensure daily collection and safe disposal of the garbage from the garbage dump "kudadaan" located in the residential area of the petitioner.
- (b) Direct the respondent for relocation of the above-mentioned garbage dump "kudadaan" at a safe distance from the residential area and the Schools located in that area of the petitioner, 161 Jogabai Extension, Jamia Nagar, Batla House, Okhla New Delhi-110025.
- (c) Allow the present writ petition of the Petitioner and pass a writ, order or direction in the nature of writ of mandamus thereby directing the respondent to provide for a proper waste disposal mechanism or facility to the local residents.

2. A status report dated 29th May, 2026 has been handed over on behalf of the respondent/MCD in court and the same is taken on record.

3. As per the said status report, the respondent/MCD has made proper



arrangements for collection, cleaning and disposal of garbage/municipal solid waste in the said area on a daily basis. Photographs have been filed along with the status report to show that the entire garbage has been removed.

4. Mr. Oberoi, counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent/MCD submits that municipal staff in the said area has been sensitized to carry out garbage disposal on a regular basis.

5. Taking on record the aforesaid assurance, the present writ petition is disposed of with the direction that the respondent/MCD shall ensure that the garbage is lifted on a regular basis and cleanliness is maintained in the locality.

6. In the event the petitioner has any further grievance, the petitioner is at liberty to approach the Court.
