1. The lawyers are abstaining from work today.
2. Proxy counsel are present for the parties.
3. The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following reliefs:-

a) Issue a Writ of Certiorari or any other appropriate writ, order, or direction, setting aside and quashing the if any oral rejection/deemed refusal of License Application Reference No. 20112024117801 dated 20.11.2024, being arbitrary, non-speaking, discriminatory, and violative of the principles of natural justice and Articles 14, 19(1)(g), and 21 of the Constitution of India;

b) Issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order, or direction, directing the Respondent Corporation to forthwith grant the Meat Shop License to the Petitioner, the application having fulfilled all prescribed statutory and municipal requirements, and there being no lawful or sustainable ground for denial and quash if any rejection order; and

4. Proxy counsel on instructions from the petitioners submits that an appeal has been filed by the petitioner before the Deputy Commissioner, Shahdara, South Zone, MCD. He submits that the petitioner would be



satisfied if the aforesaid appeal is decided in an expeditious manner.

5. Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of while directing that the appeal of the petitioner be decided within four (4) weeks, after giving a personal hearing to the petitioner.

6. No observations have been made on the merits of the case.

7. Liberty is given to the petitioner to approach this Court in the event of any grievance with the order passed by the SDM.
