1. By virtue of the present application, the petitioner seeks release of the surety bond and amount of Rs.50,000/- lying with the learned Registrar General of this Court in the captioned petitioner as per the Settlement dated 25.08.2025 entered into between the parties before the Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre (**DHCMCC**).
