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1. *Mr. Rajeev M. Roy*, counsel appearing for the Insurance Company, seeks leave to withdraw the present petition, with liberty to raise all contentions, during the course of arguments, on the basis of the evidence already led, and the records of the criminal proceedings, which have been requisitioned before the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal (***MACT***).
