1. None is present on behalf of respondent no.3. On 02.12.2025, respondent nos. 3 and 4 were granted time to file the counter affidavit, failing which right to file the counter affidavit on behalf of the said respondents, was to be forfeited.

6. Needless to state that if the grievance of the petitioners is not fully mitigated, they shall be at liberty to take appropriate recourse in accordance with law.
7. With the aforesaid observations, the instant petition stands disposed of.
