ORDER

1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.
2. The present petition has been filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India seeking initiation of contempt proceedings against the Respondents for alleged wilful disobedience and non-compliance of the order dated 20.03.2026 passed by this Court in **W.P.(C) No. 9177/2025**.
3. Learned counsel appearing for the Respondents, on advance notice, submits that a restoration order dated 29.05.2026 has already been passed.
4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that though the restoration order has been passed, the same pertains to the Academic Session 2025-26 and not to the Academic Session 2026-27.
5. In view of the above, the Respondents are directed to issue a revised



restoration order in respect of the Petitioner, specifically permitting it to participate in the counselling process from the Academic Session 2026-27 instead of 2025-26. The said order shall also be communicated to the concerned University.

6. Let the needful be done before 19.06.2026.
7. The petition is disposed of in the above terms with liberty to the Petitioners to seek revival of the present petition in case the aforesaid directions are not complied with.
8. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
9. The order be uploaded on the website forthwith.
