ORDER

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1. Petitioner seeks issuance of writ in nature of mandamus to the respondent to release him on *parole* for a period of six weeks to enable him to file *Special Leave Petition* (SLP) before Hon'ble Supreme Court challenging the judgment whereby his appeal was dismissed on 20.09.2019 by learned Divisions Bench of this Court.
