ORDER

1. Ms. Amita Singh Kalkal, counsel for the Petitioner, submits that subsequent to the filing of the present petition, the Petitioner has been served with a copy of the order dated 2nd July, 2026 passed by Respondent No. 2, whereby the Petitioner's representation has been rejected pursuant to the decision of the concerned Committee of the Delhi High Court taken in its meeting held on 6th May, 2026.

2. In view of the aforesaid development, Ms. Kalkal seeks leave to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail of appropriate remedies in accordance with law, including laying a challenge to the order rejecting the



Petitioner's representation.

3. Since the Court has not examined the merits of the case and the request for withdrawal has been made at the threshold, the same is allowed. The Petitioner is granted liberty to avail of such remedies as may be available in law.

4. The petition is, accordingly, dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
