**ORDER**

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**13.05.2026**

1. Pursuant to the order passed by this Court on 17<sup>th</sup> February, 2026, a status report has been filed on behalf of the respondent no.2/ SHO, P.S. Jamia Nagar. The relevant extract from the said status report is set out below:



8. From the enquiry conducted so far, it has revealed that some unknown persons misused the Aadhaar ID of Smt. Raj Verma and prepared forged property documents in her name. By using these fabricated documents, they filed a false writ petition before the Hon'ble Delhi High Court, despite her having no connection with the property or the case. It also emerged that similar incident are occurring in areas like Jamia Nagar and Shaheen Bagh. In such cases, forged documents are used to file complaints and PILs regarding illegal construction. These acts are done with ulterior motives to extort money from innocent persons. After receiving money, the accused either withdraw or stop pursuing the cases in the Court.

9. It is also pertinent to mention here that a case FIR No. 497/25 Dt. 17.12.2025, U/s 308(2)/336/340/341/339/61(1) BNS, PS Jamia Nagar, New Delhi has been registered as per direction of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in W.P.(C) 6974/2025 titled Adity Shivcharan Rathod V/s MCD & Ors., on similar type of allegations with regard to another property. The case is pending investigation. An CM Appl. 3835/2026 filed on behalf of respondent No. 4 (Javed, land owner) in the above disposed of writ petition W.P.(C) 6974/25 was listed before Hon'ble Delhi High Court and vide order

dated 20.01.2026, the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi has directed that the respondent No. 2/SHO P.S. Jamia Nagar shall carry out wider investigation so as to include the modus operandi followed by the persons who are filing such writ petitions in fictitious names. Hence, the present matter may be clubbed and allegations may be investigated with the case FIR No. 497/26 PS Jamia Nagar, New Delhi.

2. Counsel appearing for the respondent no.2/ SHO, P.S. Jamia Nagar submits that the filing of the present writ petition shall be investigated as a part of the aforesaid FIR referred to hereinabove.

3. Accordingly, in view of the stand taken by the petitioner that she did not authorise the filing of the present petition and the petition does not bear her signatures, the petition is dismissed.
