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1. The grievance of the petitioners in the present writ petition is with regard to holding of marriage functions at Mini Stadium Park, Naraina Vihar, New Delhi, a public park located at Naraina Village Road.
2. Counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners do not have any grievance insofar as the religious functions are organized in the said park. The grievance is only in terms of marriage functions which are held at the said park, which causes inconvenience to the residents.
3. In the status report filed on behalf of the respondent/ MCD on 10th December, 2024, it has clearly been stated that marriage and other social functions were discontinued with effect from March 2021. The relevant



extracts from the status report are set out below:

- c) That the Mini Stadium, is also being used for the purpose of holding religious functions like Ramlila, Janmasthmi etc and a permanent platform/chabutra is existing for more than 20 years for the purpose of performing aforesaid religious functions.
- d) It is also significant to mention here that the online booking of this site for marriages and other social function was discontinued w.e.f. March, 2021 and since then it is only being used for religious functions.

4. Counsel for the petitioner submits that despite the aforesaid stand, marriage functions continue to be held at the said park. It is submitted that as recently as 8th-10th February, marriage functions were organized at the said park.

5. Taking note of the aforesaid submission, a direction is issued to the respondent/ MCD as well as SHO, Naraina Vihar to strictly ensure that the aforesaid park is not used for purposes of marriage and other social functions.

6. The petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
