1. Application under Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (CPC) has been filed on behalf of the Decree Holder/Respondent for release of the decretal amount /demand draft along with accrued interest deposited in this Court pursuant to Order dated 29.11.2021.
2. The record shows that the Appeal has been dismissed *vide* Order dated 15.01.2026.
3. Learned Counsel for the Appellants has an objection and seeks mediation in the matter.
4. Once the Appeal has been dismissed, nothing more survives in the matter.
5. Let the decretal amount along with interest that has been accrued, be



released in favour of the Respondent in accordance with law.

6. It has been clarified by the learned Counsel for the Respondent that the deposited amount was only 50% of the decretal amount and that he shall be pursuing their execution for the recovery of the balance amount.
